



**GET YER HAPPY ON TOUR COMING TO EVANSVILLE, IN
FEATURING SANDI PATTY AND PATSY CLAIRMONT**

Working from their first-hand experience of this fact, good friends Sandi Patty and Patsy Clairmont have teamed up and hit the road. The two acclaimed performers have packaged a bundle of insights, set them to some lively rhythms, and are encouraging audiences across the country this spring. The **Get Yer Happy On** Tour with Sandi Patty and Patsy Clairmont will be at The Aiken Theatre at The Centre in Evansville, IN on Friday, March 2, 2012, 7:00 PM. Sandi Patty was introduced to the entertainment world in 1986 with her rendition of “The Star Spangled Banner” during the televised rededication of the Statue of Liberty. Overnight she became one of America’s best-loved performers. Her version of the national anthem has become synonymous with patriotic celebration, with performances at “A Capitol Fourth” with the National Symphony, the Indianapolis 500, the Dedication of the Camp David Chapel, and ABC’s “Fourth of July Special”.

As one of the most highly acclaimed performers of our time, with five Grammy® awards, four Billboard Music Awards, three platinum records, five gold records, and eleven million units sold; Sandi Patty is known simply as The Voice. The most awarded female vocalist in contemporary Christian music history, Sandi Patty has received 40 Dove Awards as well as being inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame. She has released more than 30 albums, including her latest Dove Award winning project, “The Edge of the Divine” (2010).

Petite, profound, and playful are words often used to describe Patsy Clairmont’s size, her message, and her humor. With her quick wit and fast-paced humor, Patsy keeps everyone laughing. This light touch combined with deep insights makes Patsy an unusual package.

Clairmont’s years of suffering as a prisoner in her own home – a victim of agoraphobia – have given her a deep appreciation of God’s healing power. From her emotionally troubled background, Patsy tells how God has combined her humor and her insights to remind audiences that imperfect, “cracked” people are God’s specialty.

Patsy now travels throughout the U.S. providing humor and hope. Currently, she is a speaker with the Women of Faith conferences, speaking to tens of thousands of women each month. In her fourteen years with Women of Faith she has spoken to more than 4 million women. Patsy is also the author of the best-selling books *God Uses Cracked Pots*, *Normal is Just a Setting on Your Dryer*, *Sportin’ a Tude*, and several others.
